Nominate the general practices and staff members you think have gone above and beyond in providing end of life care.

The Daffodil Standards Awards celebrates the contributions general practice teams have made to providing excellent end of life care.

From GPs to receptionists and other general practice staff, we want to know who you think deserves recognition.

What are the Daffodil Standards?

Developed by the Royal College of General Practitioners (RCGP) and Marie Curie, the Daffodil Standards help practices identify where improvements can be made to the end of life care being delivered.

Today, one in five practices across the UK have signed up to the standards. These practices display the Daffodil Mark, highlighting their commitment to excellent end of life care.

Who can I nominate?

Any GP practice or staff member in a practice signed up to the Daffodil Standards can be nominated for an award. You can also nominate yourself.

How do I nominate someone?

Nominations are open on the RCGP website and free to enter. Search **rcgp.org.uk** for Daffodil Standards Awards.



What are the award categories?

GP of the year

We're looking for someone who has helped to turn a struggling practice around, helped improved the morale and wellbeing of their colleagues, or campaigned for change on end of life practices in their local area.

General practice of the year

This award seeks to recognise a struggling practice that has been turned around, improved the morale and wellbeing of staff and patients, or campaigned for a change on end-of-life practices in their local area.

General practice team member of the year

This award will recognise a member of the wider general practice team who's made a positive impact on improving patient care, practice efficiency or their clinical workload – from practice nurses to social prescribing link workers.

Management and receptionist general practice team member of the year

We're looking for outstanding Practice Managers or Receptionists who've demonstrated a keen desire to deliver the best possible patient- focused services, for example a receptionist or reception team.

Rising star of the year

Open to all UK medical graduates in postgraduate training, we're looking for someone who's demonstrated enthusiasm, a keen desire to learn, imagination, and a contribution to improving end of life care.
